



Nursing Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)

Armstrong Atlantic State University

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) assesses the academic preparedness of entry-level nursing students in Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage.

A passing score of 75 and above is required for the TEAS. If your score is lower than 75, you will need to retake the test and achieve a higher score. Students may only take the test **twice** during a twelve month period. If the student has taken the TEAS more than once, **the most recent score will be used for admission to the program.**

TEAS tests are given the first and third Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. in Room 228 Ashmore Hall. The test will last for approximately 3 hours and 29 minutes.

You must have an application in order to pay for the TEAS. The cost of the test is \$35.00 (non-refundable). Applications can be picked up at the Department of Nursing (Ashmore Hall) or printed from our website.

Payment must be in the form of a cash, credit or debit.  
Personal checks will not be accepted.

Payment in person:

Bring your application to the bursar's office in Burnett Hall Room 133.

Registering in person:

Bring your payment receipt and application to the Department of Nursing Room 216 (Ashmore Hall) Monday thru Friday 8:15 am to 5 pm to schedule a testing time.

You will need your Pirate's Cove username and password to access the computers. If you are not an AASU student, you will be given a guest username and password. You will be able to view your scores immediately following the test.

# What is the TEAS?

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) assesses the academic preparedness of entry-level nursing students in Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage.

- Reading: students will demonstrate reading skills in paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension, and inferences and conclusions.
  - o 50 minutes 40 questions
- Math: will measure their knowledge of whole numbers, metric conversion, fractions and decimals, algebraic application, percentages, ratio and proportion, and data interpretation.
  - o 56 minutes 45 questions
- Science: scientific reasoning, life science, chemical science, physical science, human body science, and general science.
  - o 38 minutes 30 questions
- English: students will tackle punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, contextual words, and spelling.
  - o 65 minutes 55 questions

The total testing time is 3 hours and 29 minutes.
